We would love for pupils to engage with the four stories in as many different ways as possible. We would like to invite all pupils to enter **THE PICTURE BOOK AWARD 2024 ART COMPETITION**.

Entry Criteria:

- Children are invited to submit one picture illustrating a scene/character from one of the shortlisted books.
- We would be grateful if the art entries could be individual entries to enable the judges to make a fair decision on the best one.
- Children may use any medium they choose including collage.
- All competition entries must be A4/3 in size but any paper/card/medium can be used .
- We regret that we cannot accept larger pieces of artwork.

Please make ensure a label (supplied in the pack provided with your books) showing pupil's name, school and book used for inspiration is attached to the back of their entry.

Ideas:

You and your pupils may be inspired by the books in many ways! The children can be given an entirely free rein or you may use this as a whole class teaching opportunity.

You can use some of the ideas in this booklet as a starting point or feel free to completely surprise us.
